Catalina Island Marathon Aid Station – Saturday, March 10, 2018

Assist in setting up the aid station at Middle Ranch Junction, cut fruit, pour water and Gatorade and cheer on the runners. Approximate time volunteers needed: 7:30am-3pm.

Catalina Island Conservancy Ball - Saturday, April 14, 2018

This is one of the Conservancy's largest volunteer-driven events! Volunteers are needed to help set up the casino ballroom the day before, assist with the live and silent auctions during the ball, and help pack up the next day.

On-Going Volunteer Opportunities

Thursday Mornings at the Nursery - Volunteers will be driven to the Native Plant Nursery in Middle Ranch (dependent on driver availability and weather) and assist with any horticultural needs; transplanting, weeding, watering, outplanting, etc. Transportation is provided and departs from the Conservancy House promptly at 7:30am and returns by noon (please arrive a few minutes early). Wear hiking boots, bring bottled water and sun protection. Please reserve your spot at least 48 hours in advance.

Windward Beach Clean-Up – Every second Saturday of the month (dependent on driver availability and weather). Enjoy the great outdoors while combing through the sand for debris at one or more of our beautiful windward beaches (Shark Harbor, Little Harbor, Cottonwood & Ben Weston). Transportation is provided, leaving Avalon from the Conservancy House at 9am. Bring bottled water and sun protection.

NEW OFFERING (summer only) Mornings in the Field ~ Every Wednesday through July / 8am-noon assist in the interior - Possibilities include trails maintenance, invasive plant removal, assist with exclosure removal, weed restoration sites, and airport garden maintenance. Transportation provided, departing from the Conservancy House promptly at 8:00am and you'll return to Avalon by noon. Please wear hiking boots or sturdy shoes, bring bottled water and sun protection. Please reserve your spot at least 48 hours in advance.
